LUNCH:

- Students can purchase lunch or bring lunch from home.
- CCA is a Peanut Free school.
- Lunches are paid for out of a pre-paid account. You may <u>pay online</u> or send a check in advance to CCA
 and in the memo line please note student lunch ID number. This can be sent to your child's teacher. For
 online payments, please request a student ID from the cafeteria manager.
- Lunch price: \$3.50 Breakfast: \$2.25
- Parents are welcome to visit and eat lunch with their child. However please be aware that bringing in outside food is not allowed. Parents may purchase a lunch.
- Free or reduced lunch is available for eligible families please contact the cafeteria manager for information.
- If a lunch account gets below zero, a note will be sent home. The student will be given a sandwich lunch until the account is paid.

CCA UNIFORM DRESS CODE

A higher standard of dress encourages greater respect for individuals, students and others, and results in a higher standard of behavior. Our dress code guidelines indicate appropriate school uniform during normal school days. CCA reserves the right to interpret these guidelines and/or make



changes during the school year. Students are expected to follow these guidelines. Every student in attendance shall wear the CCA official school uniform from "ALL UNIFORM WEAR" or UNIFORM SOURCE. If you are in financial need in regards to purchasing uniforms, please contact the school for assistance.

ELEMENTARY - K-5th

Shirt: red

Bottoms: khaki or navy skorts, shorts or pants

PE: K-4 - PE uniform is optional; may be worn all day

5th - full PE uniform is required and may be worn all day

MIDDLE SCHOOL - 6th-8th

Shirt: navy or white

PE: all middle school students will have 1 semester of PE/health, with 6 weeks of health and 6 weeks of PE. Students will dress out in full PE uniform and may bring a separate bag for PE items.

- **PE Top** PE shirt or spirit wear shirt is acceptable.
- **PE Bottoms** mesh athletic shorts or navy sweatpants with the school logo.
- **PE Shoes** all students K-8th must wear appropriate athletic footwear and socks to PE class. The footwear must have a way of tightening the shoe (laces or velcro) to ensure a correct and safe fit. Examples of inappropriate shoes are slip-ons, dress shoes, heels, backless, boots, boat shoes, etc.
- Hair: Hair must be neat and clean with no "unnatural" colors, i.e. fluorescent, bright green, etc. Hair must be combed
 down without spikes. Students may not have hair hanging in their face that obstructs their eyes. Hairstyles disruptive to
 the learning environment will not be permitted. No hats or bandanas may be worn. Headbands may only be worn if holding hair back and may not be worn across the forehead.
- Shoes: Students must wear closed toe and closed back shoes at all times. No heavy military type boots or shoes with metal tips may be worn. No roller skate shoes or light-up sneakers are permitted. No slip on type shoes or high heels. Athletic shoes can be worn but must be simple with laces or Velcro. Boots are acceptable in winter months.
- Socks: Students may wear any color socks.
- Shirts: All shirts must be tucked in and must have the CCA logo. Only plain white undershirts may be worn under the uniform shirt, except during the winter months when long sleeve shirts can be worn, but must be either solid white, blue or red. Additionally, no pictures, writings or patterns may be worn.
- Pants/Shorts: All uniform pants/shorts must be worn with a solid belt and be in good repair. Shorts may not be shorter than 3 inches above the knee. All uniform bottoms must have the CSUSA logo.
- **Skorts:** All skorts must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.
- Jeans & Spirit Wear Days: Students may wear jeans every Friday for \$1.00 or free with Tiger Club membership. CCA spirit shirts may also be worn at no charge. There will be other special Spirit theme days throughout the school year. Guidelines for those will be published as needed.
- Outerwear: Outwear worn in the building must have a CCA logo. Jackets or sweaters must have the school logo. Students may also wear CCA spirit wear hoodies. Parents are encouraged to add their child's name to all uniformed clothing in case of misplacement. Non-CCA jackets and hoodies may be worn to school but may not be worn inside the school building.
- **Jewelry:** No body piercing other than earrings. Earrings should be stud style only for safety purposes. Students may wear a watch and one thin necklace that is tucked into the shirt.
- **General:** No sports bands (wrist, head or ankle) may be worn at school. At no time are students to wear anything offensive, immodest or deemed inappropriate by the faculty.
- Backpacks: Students may use their backpack of choice, no rolling backpacks.

Cold Weather Uniform Guidelines:

A solid white, blue or red undershirt (such as a turtleneck) may be worn under the school polo or school shirt. Another option on cold days is to purchase the long-sleeve school uniform polo from the uniform providers. Girls may wear tights or leggings under skorts.

Spirit Wear Policy

- Spirit Wear tops may be worn each Friday at no charge with a uniform bottom or jeans. Spirit Wear may also be worn for a PE top. Hoodies and sweatshirts may be worn as outerwear each day. A uniform shirt must be underneath.
- Jeans Days every Friday! Jeans may be worn for \$1.00 or are free with Tiger Club membership.





CHEROKEE CHARTER ACADEMY VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

* STATE MANDATED REPORTER CERTIFICATE REQUIRED *

The State Charter School Commission has mandated that all parent volunteers must complete mandated reporter training for child abuse and neglect. A list will be maintained in the front office of who has completed the training. Anyone not on this list will not be allowed in the building to volunteer. This includes classroom volunteers, lunch duty, carpool duty and PTC events.

There are two options for training. We will offer a class once school begins or you may do a free online course. If you participate in the online course, you will need to send in a printed copy of the certificate of completion or email a copy to: volunteers@cherokeecharter.org.

Volunteer FAQ

Expected Hours

- 20 hours per family with one CCA student.
- 30 hours per family with more than one student.

What counts as volunteer hours?

- working any PTC events
- attending meetings Curriculum Night, PTC meetings, teacher conferences
- volunteering in classroom per teacher needs
- donation of items (\$10.00 spent = 1 hour)

How do donations count toward volunteer hours?

\$10.00 equals 1 service hour. Receipts must be turned in to your teacher for classroom supplies or the project manager for an event. Receipts must be marked with your name and what it is for. Enter the donation as hours into PowerSchool.

* Where can I find volunteer opportunities?

The PTC uses SignUp Genius to sign-up to work or to donate items to an event. The URL and login information is at the top of this page. To see what is coming up, a list of PTC events is listed on this back of this page and the PTC calendar is available.

* How do I volunteer in the classroom?

Each teacher will have their own needs for the classroom, so check with your teacher and let them know you are willing to help.

* Where do I log/enter volunteer hours?

Volunteer hours are logged through PowerSchool. If you are new to CCA, your login information will be given to you by your homeroom teacher. Families are encouraged to enter their hours often to keep track for the year. Hours are approved by administration.

CHEROKEE CHARTER ACADEMY, INC. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Cherokee Charter Academy, Inc. (CCA, Inc.) was formed as a 501(c) 3 non-profit and currently holds the school's charter, which was granted by Georgia State Charter Schools Commission (SCSC). The SCSC is the state agency that has oversight over most of the state's charter schools. The CCA, Inc. Board is the governing body over Cherokee Charter Academy. Our Board is comprised of community leaders and parents responsible for overseeing all aspects of the school. Amongst its duties, the Board is responsible for:

- Approval of the school budget and finances.
- Operational oversight, including oversight of the schools two largest vendors Charter Schools USA (the school's Educational Service Provider) and Red Apple (the school's facilities provider).
- Setting and review of school-specific performance goals and strategic plans.

The CCA, Inc. Board meets at least 10 times annually and welcomes parents to the meetings. The board observes Roberts Rules of Orders, therefore, audience members are offered an opportunity to speak at the end of the meeting but the board does not participate in an exchange during audience dialog. Board member may direct parents to proper sources information or school officials to assist audience members with issue resolution. Board meetings are held at 10:00 am at CCA in all months except July and December. While they establish a meeting calendar, conflicts do occur and changes in meeting dates/times are posted timely on our website and at the school. The Board may have special called meetings periodically and these will also be posted in the same locations.
